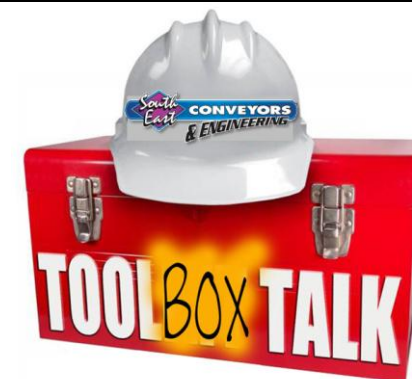

#### Are your chemicals correctly stored and labelled?

Many products commonly found in and around your home and work place may be hazardous. Products like ammonia, thinners, common cleaning materials can react violently if mixed, or cause permanent health effects.

Storing Paints, cleaners, oil, other flammable liquids, or hazardous chemicals in coke / water bottles or other containers not designed for the purpose can result in poisoning or serious accidents and is illegal in a workplace.



#### Consider the following:

-  All chemicals must be kept or stored in the correct containers and clearly labelled.
-  Different types of chemicals e.g. powders and liquids, should be kept separate as they could react violently if accidentally mixed
-  Don't store flammable liquids or gasses near naked flames or electrical equipment
-  Make sure that information on the chemicals in particular the Safety Data Sheet (SDS) is available
-  Do not use drinking bottles for any other purposes.
